Agricultural Services and Producer Organizations Project SIL (FY04)	12/11/2003	06/29/2004	09/30/2008	20.0	12.8	The development objective of the proposed Agricultural Services and Producer Organizations Project (ASPOP) is to increase agricultural productivity and rural incomes while preserving the natural resource base. The proposed project would support this objective by financing productivity-raising interventions and strengthening the institutional and technical capacities of producer organizations, government institutions, and private support services.

In terms of education, this means providing universal quality basic education by 2015. This project is the first 5-year phase of this long term endeavor, which is one of in-depth policy and institutional reforms. Its objective is to ensure that the framework for quality universal basic education is in place and ready for implementation. It places an emphasis on developing an effective partnership between the State and the communities, creating a national technical capacity for curricula and textbook development, and improving basic education quality and efficiency. At the end of the project, these objectives will translate into stronger institutional and managerial capacity, increased enrollment rates, more equitable access and better education quality and efficiency.

This is also the objective of the National Transport Program which is financed only in part by the project (roughly 25%), and in part by other donors and the Government.

Achievement of these objectives will be measured by the following in project areas: an increase in the coverage of basic health services, the percentage of operational health districts, and an increase in health facilities utilization rates.

Petroleum Sector Management Capacity Bldg (FY00)	06/06/2000	03/23/2001	04/30/2006	23.7	0.1	The development objective is to strengthen Chad's capacity to: (i) manage the development of its petroleum resources in an environmentally and socially sound manner; (ii) minimize & mitigate potential negative environmental and social impacts of the Doba Petroleum Project on the producing region, strengthen local capacity in the region, and provide opportunities for the region's residents to improve their living conditions; and (iv) establish an effective framework for further sound private investment in the petroleum sector, and engage effectively with investors.
